
Exemptions under the California and the State of Washington Brake Pad Laws

Listed WA Exemptions Only:

- Race cars, dual-sport vehicles, or track day vehicles, whose primary use is for off-road purposes and are permitted¹
- Collector vehicles²
- Brake friction material for a specific motor vehicle model or class of motor vehicles that has been issued an exemption³
- Friction materials that can be used on both exempted and nonexempted vehicles must comply unless they are clearly labeled as intended for a use that is exempted¹²

<u>WA Law only:</u> Tractor trailers are not considered a motor vehicle and therefore are exempt.

California Department of Toxic Substances Control

Listed CA Exemptions¹³ Only:

 Motor vehicles subject to voluntary or mandatory recalls of brake friction materials or systems.
Exemption expires once recall is lifted.

• Motor vehicles manufactured by small volume manufacturers.

 Vehicles manufactured prior to January 1, 2021, and brake friction materials for use on vehicles manufactured prior to January 1, 2021 are exempt from the January 1, 2021 requirements.

 Vehicles manufactured prior to January 1, 2025, and brake friction materials for use on vehicles manufactured prior to January 1, 2025, from the January 1, 2025 requirements.

• Vehicles for which receive an extension from the January 1, 2025 requirements.

<u>CA Law only:</u> All trailers, including tractor trailers and boat trailers, are captured by the definition of "vehicle" under California Vehicle Code section 670. Some trailers may be exempt if they meet the specific exemption requirements set forth in HSC Section 25250.55.
